THIS JUST IN.... Fly into Salt Lake City in the morning and you can ski free that day at one of **Park City's** three resorts, 35 miles from the airport, as part of a promotion called Quick Start Vacation (limited dates through April 16, parkcityinfo.com).... The 163 rooms at downtown **Seattle's** new Hotel Max feature works by local painters and photographers and flat-screen TVs (hotelmax.seattle.com, introductory rates from \$129).... On December 15, the popular King Tut exhibit arrives at **Museum of Art Fort Lauderdale**, where it will remain through April 23 (954/462-0222, kingtut.org, \$30).... On January 27, **Salzburg** kicks off a yearlong celebration of the 250th anniversary of Mozart's birthday with Viva!Mozart, a program which includes interactive period dancing (mozart2006.com, \$10).... See rare breeds from Australia's Northern Territories—flying foxes, rainbow lorikeets, frilled lizards—at **Animal Planet Australia: Wild Extremes**, debuting December 16 at the **National Aquarium in Baltimore** (aqua.org, adults \$19.50, kids \$13.50).... The new **Madrid Card**—which comes in 24-, 48-, or 72-hour increments (\$30, \$42, and \$54, respectively)—grants access to 43 main museums and attractions, free bus transportation, and discounts at stores and restaurants (madridcard.com).... **Museum of Contemporary Art North Miami** has doubled its gallery space with the MOCA at Goldman Warehouse, an annex in the burgeoning Wynwood neighborhood (mocanomi.org, \$2).... **Disneyland Resort Express**, a bus running between Disneyland and two Southern California airports (Orange County's John Wayne Airport and Los Angeles International), has increased frequency to every half hour (airportbus.com, from \$14).
